Position Summary: Responsible for the fundraising development of Striving for More; assisting Development Director with setting fundraising goals; and identifying future opportunities for growth. Serve as the liaison between the Board of Directors and the Development Director.

Commitment - 2 years

Time required - 1.5-3 hours weekly

- Recruit fundraising sub-committees to help with looking for future fundraising growth opportunities and developing them.
- Assist and encourage the teams to plan the best fundraisers possible
- Reports fundraising plans and progress to Board on a regular basis.
- Oversees the accurate and timely reporting of fundraising income.
- Attends or appoints a representative to attend as many fundraising events as possible.
- Assists in identifying donor prospects having the potential to give.

Striving for More is a Triangle-based nonprofit organization dedicated to ensuring that children with cancer and their families receive quality emotional and spiritual support. The organization was founded by Diane Moore in 2008 after her nine-year-old daughter, Colleen, lost her battle with cancer.
